



Outcomes for 2005-06 Graduates by Undergraduate College

NOTES:

- This is a **98%** success rate within six months of graduation.
- This report is based on those graduates who reported their status. 9.5% of the graduating class were either delaying their search for employment/advanced study or never responded to multiple data requests. This response rate is well above most institutions.
- Creighton salary data is higher than Midwest averages for the College of Arts and Sciences and the School of Nursing based on data from the National Association of Colleges and Employers.
- This report includes data from December, 2005, May, 2006 and August, 2006 degree recipients.
- 53% of our traditional students are enrolled into professional or graduate school immediately after their educational career at Creighton. This includes 65% of A&S, 18% for CoBA, and 13% for Nursing. These figures include students who left prior to a degree from Creighton for early admission into Creighton's or another University's professional program. (Pharmacy, OT, PT, etc.) The 53% direct enrollment rate to professional & graduate school is one of the nation's highest.
