

“Mike and Josie Harper Center”

The Center for Student Life and Learning, which will be named for Charles M. “Mike” Harper and his late wife, Josie Harper, is a signature anchor to Creighton University’s campus master plan and eastward expansion. Designed to be a one-stop center, the 214,000 square foot, four-story building will unite academics and related services typically scattered across campus, including admissions, financial aid, health and counseling services and much more. This integration is unique among universities in the Midwest. It will also serve as a front door to the campus—offering visitors, alumni, prospective students, faculty and the Omaha community an engaging entrance to the University.

Completion date is set for late summer 2008.
